

One-time power of attorney for parcel pickup at the GLS ParcelShop

If you cannot pick up your parcel at the ParcelShop yourself, you can give a person you trust a written power of attorney to receive the parcel for you. To do so, simply use the following power of attorney template, which you fill out, sign and give to the authorized person. The authorized person can pick up the parcel for you at the GLS ParcelShop upon presentation of the power of attorney and his or her valid ID card, passport or corresponding international identification document.
