Tyre/wheel logistics*

The following packaging tips should be kept in mind when sending tyres and wheels:

- When sending tyres, protect them with cardboard or film.
- When sending tyres, take particular care to ensure that the parcel label is firmly affixed to the outer packaging.
- The following maximum measures must not be exceeded:
 - Height 60 cm, width 80 cm, length 200 cm
 - Girth 300 cm
 - Weight 40 kg, for express international 50 kg

Tyres with wheel rims

can only be sent completely packaged in cardboard boxes (max. one tyre on rim per parcel).

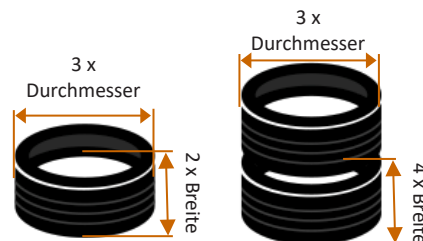
→ Girth max. 300 cm =
 $2 \times \text{height} + 2 \times \text{width} + 1 \times \text{length}$



Car tyres without rim

can be sent individually or in bundles of two.

→ Girth max. 300 cm =
 Individual: $3 \times \text{outer diameter} + 2 \times \text{tyre width}$
 Bundle: $3 \times \text{outer diameter} + 4 \times \text{tyre width}$



Calculation of the girth based on the tyre data – example tyre size 245/40 R 18

Outer diameter: $245 \times 40 / 500 + 18 \times 2.54 = 65.32 \text{ cm}$

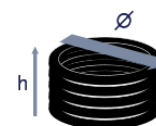
Tyre width: $245 / 10 = 24.50 \text{ cm}$

→ Girth of 1 tyre: $3 \times 65.32 + 2 \times 24.5 = 244.96 \text{ cm}$

→ Girth of a bundle of 2: $3 \times 65.32 + 4 \times 24.5 = 293.96 \text{ cm}$

Bicycles and motorbikes

When bundling tyres for bicycles and motorcycles, the height of the parcel must not exceed the diameter of one tyre.



* During the tyre season from 1 October to 31 December and from 1 March to 31 May, the surcharge "Season tyres" is calculated according to the price list. The number of tyres is particularly high and varies widely during the season. In order to ensure smooth transport, however, appropriate loading and handling capacities are made available. This causes increased efforts.
